HARVEST FAIR GUIDELINES

*Failure to comply with these guidelines may result in removal from the premises
with no refund of the space reservation fee. **Please read carefully!***

1. SJH reserves the right to refuse or remove any vendor for any reason, including and not limited to problematic behavior and vending inappropriate goods/services that do not align with the mission and values of the parish.
2. Absolutely no weapons of any kind may be brought onto or sold at our campus.
3. You may not offer knockoff merchandise for sale. If you do or attempt to do so, you will be removed from the Fair without a refund. All vendors must be independent agents.
4. New York State law requires that sales tax be collected.
5. Check-in and set-up begins at 7:30am. You must check in before setting up your space. Set-up must be completed by 9:30am.
6. Drop-off/unloading is possible only on Main Street at the Garden. Please endeavor to unload as quickly as possible, moving your materials to your assigned space, returning to your car, and parking where you can (not remaining on Main Street and not at the Parish Office entrance on Prospect Street).
7. Tabletop displays are permitted as long as they do not exceed 6 feet in height from the ground and do not reasonably impede the view of another vendor. All displays in wall spaces must be kept against the wall and may not exceed the table space.
8. The Fair will be open from 10am-4pm. We kindly ask that you not pack up and leave until 4pm. Early departures will not be evaluated favorably for vendor approval in future years. You must tidy your space and depart the campus no later than 5pm.
9. All vendors shall and will hold harmless SJH from and against any and all claims, liabilities, demands out of or in any way connected with vendor use, occupancy, or activities on Saturday, October 24, 2026 at the Harvest Fair. SJH is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged property.

*Every effort is made to provide consistent vendor spaces. Due to the configuration of the aisles and room sizes, assigned space sizes will vary slightly. Once assigned, no adjustments will be made to the location or size of your space. **There are no exceptions to this!***

*You will be emailed about your space assignment approximately one week before the Fair. We will only reserve your space once full payment is received, confirming payment via email. **We appreciate your patience and understanding!***

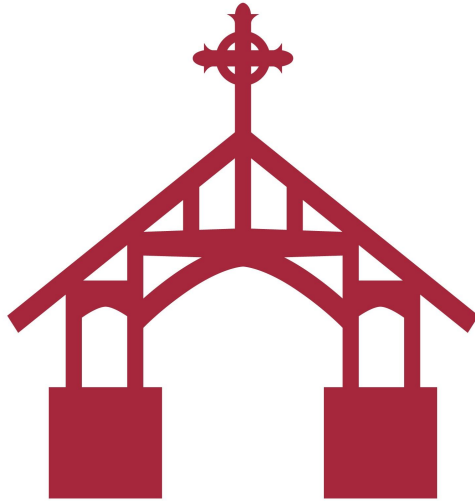
